

Underfloor Heating Guide:

All our sisal ranges of natural floor coverings can be fitted in conjunction with underfloor heating but we do **not** recommend using any of our seagrass ranges. All our wool floor coverings work well, unless otherwise stated.

Our new range of Sisal-Look carpets, an innovative synthetic faux sisal floorcovering, works particularly well as it is from man-made fibres and has a low tog rating. When fitting any of these ranges in conjunction with underfloor heating there are several procedures that need to be adhered to:

All floor coverings need to be acclimatised in situ for at least 48 hours. During this time the underfloor heating must be left on at room temperature, i.e. a comfortable ambient temperature of around 20°C.

It is essential that the underlay used is appropriate for underfloor heating. We recommend Ball & Young ranges, either Roma or Venice or where the flooring is to be double stuck either Radiance or Olympic.

If double sticking, we only recommend adhesives by F Ball: Styccobond F3 for permanent bond (floor covering to underlay) and Styccobond F40 (securing the underlay to the subfloor) as these products have been tested and deemed suitable for use with underfloor heating.
